

SHOW HAD RECORD ENTRY

A record entry of well over 2,000 bottles was magnificently displayed in the Royal Hall, Harrogate. This year the standard of the entries varied considerably from class to class. In some cases the judge was able to comment "all entries in this class were of National standard" while in others the judge was rather disappointed and found only 25 per cent of the class of an acceptable standard for the National Show.

Awards have been well distributed over the country with the northern circles having slightly the better of the battle. A really accurate analysis is rather difficult in the time available because a considerable number of awards went to unattached winemakers. The trophies were won by very small margins in some cases, the Atcherley Trophy being distinguished by a seven first prize tie! The issue was resolved by rejudging these first prize entries and the trophy went to Mr. J. H. Stephen, of Stockport, whose exhibit was judged the most meritorious. The Shaw Porter Cup went to Mrs. M. Murgatroyd, of York. The Bournemouth Master Winemakers' Cup went to Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Dunkley, of Hertford, jointly with Mrs. D. J. Gray, of Cleveland, and the "Amateur Winemaker" Shield went to York Circle. Other trophy winners are as follows:
