

# 2,000 ENTRIES IN WINE SHOW

The Wine Show, staged in the Viennese ballroom, was again a triumph for the Harrow Guild, for they won the "A.W." Shield for the most points, and their member, Mr. F. G. Bastin, carried off both the Shaw-Porter Cup and the Bournemouth Master Winemakers' Cup, and Mr. and Mrs. Adcock won the Turner Trophy for three bottles for a dinner.

Tally Ho won the handsome new Marconi trophy in the Circle single-bottle championship.

Mr. E. A. Roycroft won that most difficult trophy, the cup for the judges' and stewards' classes, the Cedric Austin Cup, and the principal brewers' award, the Wilf Newsom Cup, went to Mr. R. B. Stoks, of Harpenden. The Roycroft trophy for the wines-by-purpose classes went to Miss C. Nairn Hitchin, of Birmingham, and Major G. Instone, of Hove.

Other successful trophy winners were Mr. A. H. Ritchie, Greasby, the Hill Cup for the runner-up to the Master Winemaker, Mr. E. W. East, Bishop's Cleeve, Andrews cup for dry fruit wine, Mr. R. Butcher, the Atcherley trophy for the novices classes, Mr. L. Carpenter, the Gordon Instone Cup for the best display or invention, and Mr. R. E. French and Mr. W. Harvey, the Lucas Cup for the Bournemouth member gaining most points.

There were over 2,000 entries—a record—from some 400 exhibitors, and, from the reports of the judges, the general quality was if anything higher than last year.

The wines were well displayed, and the exhibition was completed by the trade stands of W. R. Loftus Ltd., Grey Owl Laboratories, Merrydown, the "Amateur Winemaker," a most attractive and neat display stand by the Hounslow Circle, and a display of tombola prizes. The tombola, run by Mr. Ivor Morgan, was both novel and successful, and made £67.
